Places are limited – each hike will comprise of a maximum of four clients, plus sherpas.

Participants are responsible for their own transportation, food, camping gear (a limited amount of equipment can be loaned by BCMOS) and providing at least one sherpa. However, a hiking/camping equipment checklist will be provided by BCMOS prior to departure.

All hikes cost \$10 per session, and overnight trips must be booked at least one week ahead.
